## **GED/High School Equivalency Classes for Deaf Adults**

These classes are for Deaf adults with a 7th grade or higher reading level. Instruction focuses on basic math, reading and writing in the context of the subject areas covered by the GED exam (social studies, science, language arts, reading and writing).

Classes meet for three 3-hour evening sessions per week for three semesters. Spring session: April 7 – June 18, 2009. The cost is \$99.00 per semester (including books and screening materials).
